1. General Information

- 1.1. This Privacy Policy outlines the principles for the processing and protection of personal data of users of the website www.imm2026.pl.
 - 1.2. The **Data Controller** is **IMM.PL**, the organizer of the International Mini Meeting 2026 (hereinafter: the “Controller”).

2. Scope of Data Collected

2.1. The website may collect the following data:

- Data voluntarily provided by users via forms (e.g., **first name, last name, email address, phone number**),
- Technical data, such as **IP address, browser type, operating system, time of access**, and use of **cookies**.

2.2. Personal data may be processed for the purposes of:

- Registration and ticket purchase for the **IMM 2026** event,
 - Contact with the Organizer,
 - Sending information related to the event,
 - Statistical and analytical purposes.

3. Legal Basis for Data Processing

Personal data is processed in accordance with **Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR)**, based on:

- **Art. 6(1)(b)** – processing necessary for the performance of a contract (e.g., ticket purchase),
 - **Art. 6(1)(f)** – legitimate interest of the Controller (e.g., responding to inquiries, website statistics, ensuring website security),
 - **Art. 6(1)(a)** – based on consent, when required (e.g., newsletter subscriptions).

4. Data Recipients

- 4.1. Data may be shared with entities supporting the Controller in organizing the Event (e.g., IT service providers, payment and registration service providers).
 - 4.2. Data will **not be sold or shared** with third parties for commercial purposes.
 - 4.3. Data will **not be transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA)**.

5. User Rights

Each user has the right to:

- Access their data,
 - Rectify their data,
 - Request deletion ("right to be forgotten"),
 - Restrict processing,
 - Object to processing,
 - Data portability,
 - File a complaint with the **President of the Personal Data Protection Office (UODO)**.

6. Data Retention Period

Data will be stored for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected, and additionally for the period required by law (e.g., tax, accounting), or until any potential legal claims become time-barred.

7. Data Security

The Controller applies appropriate **technical and organizational measures** to ensure the protection of personal data in accordance with applicable laws.

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on the user's device (computer, phone, tablet) while browsing the website.

2. Purpose of Cookies

The website www.imm2026.pl uses cookies to:

- Ensure proper website functionality,
 - Improve website performance and security,
 - Generate website traffic statistics and analytics,
 - Remember user preferences,
 - Enable features related to the integration with the **Kajgo** platform.

3. Types of Cookies Used

- **Necessary** – required for the website to function properly,
 - **Analytical** – used to analyze traffic and user behavior (e.g., Google Analytics),
 - **Functional** – used to remember user settings (e.g., language preferences),
 - **External/Third-Party** – related to external services and integrations (e.g., apps or embedded content).

4. Managing Cookies

Users can manage cookies through their browser settings. Options include:

- Accepting all cookies,
- Restricting cookie use,
- Blocking all cookies entirely.

Please note that **restricting cookies may impact the functionality** of certain website features.
