

EVENT REGULATIONS

International Mini Meeting 2026

Leszno Airport, May 28 – June 1, 2026

§1 General Provisions

These regulations define the rules of participation and conduct during the event called International Mini Meeting 2026 (hereinafter: the “Event”), held at Leszno Airport from May 28 to June 1, 2026.

The Event is not a mass event within the meaning of applicable law.

The organizer of the Event is IMM.PL Sp. z o.o. (hereinafter: the “Organizer”).

The purpose of these regulations is to ensure safety and order during the Event and to define the rights and obligations of participants.

Entering the Event area constitutes acceptance of these Regulations.

§2 Admission

Entry to the Event is granted to persons who have:

- a valid ticket or accreditation,
- an identity document (in case of inspection).

Children under 16 may attend only under adult supervision.

The Organizer reserves the right to refuse entry or remove persons who:

- are intoxicated or under the influence of drugs,
- behave aggressively or pose a threat,
- violate these regulations.

§3 Prohibitions

It is forbidden to:

- bring weapons, explosives, drugs, alcohol (unless purchased on-site),
- bring large sound systems or drones without permission,
- light fires outside designated areas,
- drive vehicles outside designated zones,
- conduct trade without permission,
- litter, disturb order, or damage property.

§4 Participant Obligations

Participants must:

- follow Organizer and security instructions,

- maintain cleanliness,
- follow safety regulations,
- respect property,
- behave appropriately.

Participation is at one's own risk.

§5 Safety Rules

The area is monitored and secured.

Participants must follow all safety instructions.

The Organizer is not responsible for unattended or lost items.

§6 Image Rights

Photos and videos may be taken during the Event.

Participation implies consent to use the participant's image for promotional purposes without compensation.

§7 Liability

Participants are liable for damages caused.

The Organizer is not responsible for accidents caused by rule violations.

§8 Final Provisions

The Organizer may change the program or cancel the Event due to external reasons.

The regulations are available online, at the entrance, and at info points.

In matters not covered, the Organizer makes decisions.
